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★ Categories of Scholarships & Freeships

1. Objectives:

- To provide quality education to rural area students.
- To promote and support budding players by providing them with ample sports opportunities.
- To encourage commitment to selfless service as a guiding principle.

2. Academic Freeship :

1. Score 80 - 90% marks in 12 th exam (to get admission in UG.)	Rs.5000/- Freeship on the tuiffee head (applicable on first year fee only)
University Topper (1 st position in each semester)	Rs. 3000/- Scholarship
In top ten list of the university (as per sem.) UG	Rs. 1000/- Scholarship
University Gold Medalist	Rs. 5000/- Scholarship

3. Staff Ward Freeship:

To the ward of staff	50 % freeship on tuition fee for each academic year (staff working under the RDF).
If two or more students from a family take admission in the college	50% freeship will be provided for each ward (each academic year).

4. Sibling Freeship:

If two or more students from a family take admission to the college, then 100% Freeship will be given to the eldest child in self-financing fee head for general category students. This is applicable for boys' and girls' colleges.

5. Institutional Freeship for Economically Weak Students:

Freeship in the tuition fee head is allowed to students of this category as per the detail given below:

★ Eligibility & Compliance Rules

Note :

1. Sports Scholarships are meant for Asian, Commonwealth and Olympic Games as well as for various Shah Satnam ji Academies.
2. The continuity of the fee concession shall depend on the continuous performance of the students in their respective Sports discipline and general performance in the College recommended by the Sports In charge.

Terms and Conditions:

1. The institutional scholarship is not applicable to students who are already getting any private/govt. Scholarship.
2. The staff ward concession will not apply to part-time teachers/visiting faculty/float teachers/contractual staff and teachers on long leave.
3. In case, any employee who avails the staff ward concession leaves the institute in the middle of the academic session, the concession on fee shall be discontinued, and that employee shall have to deposit the already availed concessional amount to the institution.
4. In case of a student appearing for the second time in the same course, he/she will not be eligible for a fee concession for that period.
5. Only two children from one family of an employee will qualify for the concession.
6. Parents who are applying for concession, shall apply every year as soon as the fee payment schedule is announced before the commencement of the academic year.
7. All other fees, like Van, or any other fee collected by the college under any head will be paid in full.
8. To avail of any category concession, parents must submit all the necessary documents like application form in the prescribed format, Aadhar card, BPL card/ income certificate/self-income declaration affidavit, application duly verified by Sarpanch (village residents)/ M.C. (urban area residents), whatever is required category-wise
9. If a student pays the total fee and later on claims a concession or refund of the concession amount, then such a request after admission will not be accepted/refunded.
10. Only one category of fee concession can be availed (whichever is higher) at a time.
11. Free-ship will be granted only to those who have cleared their previous dues.

Note:

1. Fee scholarships will not be applicable to SC students who are getting the benefits of the State Post-Matric scholarship or any other government scholarship.
2. The scholarship / Free-ship will be granted after the verification of a written

claim submitted by a student through the proper channel along with all the documents/the committee constituted by the principal will verify the documents submitted by the candidate and will recommend the claim to the principal and it will be finally approved principal.

3. The Scholarship and free-ship will be claimed only in the current session in which he /she is study in the campus for consecutive years.
4. Extraordinary freeship may be considered for any exceptional student, subject to the Principal's approval and the consent of the college management.
