

# Enrolment Process



## ADMISSION PROCEDURE & ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

(For B.A. and B.Com – Semester I)

### 1. How to Apply:

Students can collect the application form and college prospectus from the college office during working days and official hours.

### 2. Eligibility Criteria:

- The student must have passed the 10+2 (Senior Secondary) examination from a recognized board.
- For students who belong to Rajasthan or have studied in a school located in Rajasthan:
  - Minimum 45% marks required in Arts or Commerce stream.
  - Minimum 48% marks required in Science stream.
- For students from outside Rajasthan (and not residents of Rajasthan):
  - Minimum 60% marks required in any stream.

### 3. Provisional Admission:

Students who are placed in a compartment in their 10+2 exam can be granted provisional admission. However, they must clear the compartment exam and submit a photocopy of their updated mark sheet (DMC) within 3 days of the result declaration. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of admission.

### 4. Admission Basis:

Admissions will be strictly on the basis of merit, as seats are limited and approved by the University.

### 5. Reservation Policy:

Candidates from SC/ST/BC or other reserved categories will be given admission as per the rules of the Government of Rajasthan and the affiliating University.

### 6. Gap Year Rule:

A gap of only one academic year is allowed between the last class attended and the current session.

### 7. Admission of Foreign Students:

Prior permission from the University is necessary before admitting any foreign student.

**Note:** All admission applications must be accompanied by relevant documents/certificates related to eligibility, reservation, weightage, and concessions. Applications without complete documentation will not be considered and are liable to be rejected.

# Admission Documentation Guidelines



## Mandatory Documents:

- 5 attested copies of the Detailed Marks Certificate (DMC) of the qualifying exam
- Original Character Certificate from the last attended institution
- Original qualifying certificate + 5 attested copies (for Boards/Universities outside Rajasthan)
- School/College Leaving Certificate
- Migration & Passing Certificates (for students outside Rajasthan Board)
- 6 passport-size & 6 ticket-size photographs  
(Sportspersons must submit 8 of each)
- Eligibility Form (for students from Boards other than RSEB)
- Gap Year Certificate (if applicable), duly attested by a competent authority

### Important Notes:

- Submit all original documents with required attested copies
- Incomplete documentation may cancel the admission
- Keep photocopies of all documents for your personal record


